Directions to Fort Lauderdale REC

Fort Lauderdale Research and Education Center (FLREC) is at 3205 College Ave., Davie, FL on the west side of Davie Rd. across from Broward Community College central campus in Davie, Florida.

Directions From the West Coast: Take I-75 across the Everglades to I-595 EAST (look for sign to Fort Lauderdale). Exit I-595 at University Drive and go south (right turn) on University Drive and in approximately 1 mile go east (left turn) onto SW 24th Street/Nova Drive. Continue east to the traffic light at College Ave. Go south (right turn) onto College Avenue. The FLREC is 1/4 mile south on the west (right) side of the street. Watch for a gap in the chain link fence and the blue-and-white UF sign.

Directions From the East: Exit I-95 or the Florida Turnpike at I-595/State Road 84 WEST. Continue on I-595 and exit at Davie Road (Exit 7), the first exit after the turnpike. After exiting I-595, turn left onto Davie Road which goes under the overpass, and continue south on Davie Road 1/2 mile to the traffic light at SW 24th Street/Nova Drive. Go west (right turn) on Nova Drive and continue to the next stop light which is College Ave. Go south (left turn) onto College Ave. The FLREC is 1/4 mile south on the west (right) side of the street. Watch for a gap in the chain link fence and the blue-and-white UF sign.
